Small-Sided Football - it's all about participation, skill development and fun

- Coaches should encourage players to pass and dribble rather than kick up-field or shoot for goal from anywhere.
- Coaches must not enter the field of play.
- Parents should offer the players encouragement but must not coach from the sidelines.
- Parents must not stand behind the goal line.
- Referees (game leaders) need to instruct players on how to play the game but must not coach their own team.
- Half-way restart after a goal is scored.
- No corners - goal line restart regardless of which team touched the ball last. Opposing team back to half-way line.
- It is not permitted to have a player permanently stationed immediately in front of the goalmouth as an attacker or defender. Referees should tell players to get involved in play.
